Tour Itinerary

Day 1 Arrival

The group arrives at the Airport. Participants are met by a representative of Hekima Safaris and transferred to a hotel.

Day 2 Arrival - Transfer to Nairobi National Park

The guest arrives at Nairobi Airport. Participants are met by a representative of Hekima Safaris and start your trip to Nairobi National park. On this tour, you'll search for the Big Five in some of Kenya's most celebrated safari parks and reserves. The tour give you the chance to visit the park in the city. Nairobi National Park boasts a large and varied wildlife population. It is one of most successful rhinoceros sanctuaries in Kenya. It was the first national park to be established in Kenya in 1946. The park has large and diverse wildlife population including lion, leopard, buffalo, black rhino, giraffe, hippo, hyena, wildebeest, zebra, cheetah, gazelle, eland, impala, hartebeest, waterbuck, warthog, olive baboon, jackal, and ostrich. Day 3 Sheldrick Elephant Orphanage

Early in the morning, we will pick you up at your hotel and start heading to heading to Sheldrick Wildlife Trust - Elephant Orphanage. As one of Africa's oldest wildlife charities and a leading conservation organization, the Sheldrick Wildlife Trust (SWT) embraces all measures that complement the conservation, preservation and protection of wildlife. You may have a chance to adopt an orphan elephant, rhino or giraffe for yourself or as a gift - offering life and hope to an animal in need. Day 4 Amboseli National Park

Amboseli National Park is a great destination for a 2-day safari. It lacks the big-cat action of the Masai Mara National Reserve, but the huge elephant herds, often encountered at

adrenaline-thumping close proximity, should make up for that. And then there is the setting. The open Savannah plains at the base of Mt Kilimanjaro form a picture-perfect African scene. In the evening you will head to your place of rest for Overnight. [Sentrim Amboseli](#)

Day 5 Amboseli National Park - Tanzania

In the early morning, you will be picked up with every of your belonging and start your day heading back to Amboseli National Park. You will do a game drive until lunch time, afterwards your trip will continue by heading near Namanga border for your transfer to Arusha, Tanzania where you will have your dinner and rest waiting for the next day. Day 6 Tarangire National Park

In the morning after breakfast your safari guide will arrive at the hotel and inform the receptionist that he is waiting for you. After meeting up with your driver you will travel to Tarangire National Park, and by 10:00 AM you will already be on your first safari! In this park you have the chance to see lots of wild Tanzanian animals (lions, buffaloes, giraffes, zebras, etc.), but above all else it is famous for its astonishing number of elephants, who typically tend to stay close to their drinking source, the Tarangire River. You should be aware that this is wild nature, so the guide cannot make any guarantees on the presence of specific wild animals, but you can be sure he will do his best to find everything you're looking for!

At lunch time you will be provided a meal, after which the safari will continue. In the evening you will be transferred to the hotel located in Karatu on the edge of the Ngorongoro volcanic crater. [Country Lodge Karatu – YOUR STEPPING STONE TO NGORONGORO CRATER](#)

Day 7 Serengeti National Park

After breakfast you will start the safari by being transferred to the central part of the Serengeti (also called Seronera). Here your driver will try to find the animals you're the most interested in. Closer to lunch time you will visit the Serengeti Visitor Centre, where you will be offered a lunchbox and provided with lots of interesting information not only about the animals' populations, but also about the history of the National Park. Also, in this area you will be able to see hyraxes, which are the elephant's closest relatives. It is difficult to describe in detail all the animals of the Serengeti valley, for they number in the thousands: elephants, buffalo, ostriches, giraffes, jackals, hyenas, lions, antelopes, leopards and cheetahs—just keep your eyes peeled and enjoy the nature around you. Day 8 Full day Serengeti National Park

After breakfast in the morning you will safari in the eastern and southern parts of the park. The greater part of these areas is a savanna with wide open spaces, which provides a likely opportunity to see cheetah hunting antelopes. Lunch boxes will be served during the game drive.

Day 9 Serengeti National Park

Day 10 Ngorongoro Crater

On this day it is best to leave the hotel as early as possible so you can see the variety of animals that are only active during the morning hours; breakfast will be packed in lunchboxes specifically for this purpose. Very early you will set off for Ngorongoro Conservation Area, and after about an hour you will already be inside the crater.

Ngorongoro is one of the most famous and interesting of Tanzania's national parks because here you can find the greatest number of different animal species per square kilometre. You will have the chance to see buffalo, elephants, lions, wildebeests, zebras, hippopotamus and feline species such as caracals and servals. The luckiest travellers might even see a rhinoceros, an animal whose numbers are rapidly declining.

By lunch time you will arrive at the lake side, where you will be offered lunchboxes, after which the safari will continue, ending in a few hours with a transfer to your hotel for dinner and overnight. Day 11 Hadza People

In the morning after breakfast your safari guide will be waiting for you. Today you will have a chance to visit and experience the real life of Hadza People and go with them for a real hunting not tourists one. Immerse yourself in the rich tribal history of the Hadzabe and Datoga tribes on this day adventure. Experience a “day in the life” of a local villager as you take part in cultural activities specific to each tribe. This is an extraordinary opportunity to witness authentic Tanzanian culture and sample local cuisine. In the evening you will be transferred at mto wa mbu for your overnight. Day 12 Mto Wa Mbu

During this day tour, you will get a chance to meet the local inhabitants of Mto wa Mbu and see how they provide for themselves. Part of the tour is experiencing how Tanzania’s lands are farmed and how its products are being processed. You’ll learn about the uses of different bananas and get a chance to try Tanzania’s very own banana beers, a local brewery of the Chagga tribe.

Furthermore we learn about some other unique trades and craftsmanship that are only practiced by certain tribes in Tanzania, like the wood-carving skills of the Makonde tribe.
