# Hekima Safaris Tour Itinerary 5 Days Annual Serengeti Migration Safari Mara-river

### Day 1 Arrival

The group arrives at Kilimanjaro Airport (JRO). Participants are met by a representative of Hekima Safaris and transferred to a lodge at Mto wa Mmbu, where you will have dinner and overnight ready for the next day to begin your safari inside Serengeti National Park.

## Day 2 Serengeti National Park

In this park you have the chance to see lots of wild Tanzanian animals (lions, buffaloes, giraffes, zebras, etc.)

You should be aware that this is wild nature, so the guide cannot make any guarantees on the presence of specific wild animals, but you can be sure he will do his best to find everything you're looking for!

At lunch time you will be provided a meal, after which the safari will continue. In the evening you will be transferred to your accommodating place

#### **Additional notes:**

This is your first day on safari, so we ask that you please pay special attention to the national park's visitor rules and our company recommendations.

- During the safari it is strictly prohibited to exit the vehicle, except for in specially designated areas. Violations of this rule may be accompanied by large fines for the company, including the revocation of its license.
- Off road driving is also prohibited, as such behaviour may cause irreparable damage to the fragile balance of the natural ecosystem.
- During the safari you are allowed to smoke, but be extremely careful about how you extinguish and dispose of cigarette butts, as they are a frequent cause of fires in the savanna.
- In addition, we sincerely request that you not put your feet on the safari car's seats, nor sit on the back of them, because this type of behaviour quickly makes the cars unusable.

## Day 3 Northern Serengeti the Mara River

Sunrise game drives in the park followed by bush breakfast. With your packed lunch drive to Mara River to Witness Crossing of wildebeests. More game drives until in the evening drive back to your accommodating place.

## Day 4 Full Day in Serengeti

After breakfast depart for a game drive. Hot lunch at the accomoda then with game drive en-route drive to Seronera for Dinner and overnight.

## Day 5 Serengeti – Ngorongoro crater

Today after breakfast we depart to Ngorongoro conservation area home to over 125 species of mammal including the fabled Big Five, the Ngorongoro Conservation Area is one of the most sought-after safari destinations in the world. It's a particularly good place to see the endangered black rhinoceros enjoying a lovely meal out on the grass plains, as well as a place to see large numbers of hippopotamus enjoying the cool water. From the comfort of your open-top vehicle, you'll be able to observe and photograph some of Africa's most recognizable faces. The crater is home to a large number of predators including lions, leopards, cheetahs, jackals, and hyenas, as well as a large population of wildebeest, zebras, antelope, Cape buffalo, and more. It is truly one of Africa's premier safari destinations. After the thrills and excitement of the day, you will have a picnic lunch by the park's famous hippo pool and later drive to your place of accommodation

## Day 6 Lake Manyara - Arusha

Today we drive to Lake Manyara National Park for a full day of game drives. This is one of Tanzania's smaller parks but still offers a rewarding and diverse safari experience. The lake-shore at Manyara teems with birdlife, and while you are looking for the birds, you might spot one of the elusive tree-climbing lions. There are a surprising number of other large mammals and the striking cliffs on the Rift escarpment form a dramatic backdrop. In the late afternoon return to Arusha then transfer to your accommodating place.

## **Day 7 Departure**

Rest in the hotel and transfer to the airport.

**Note:** Hotel check-out is at 11:00 AM. In case you need a late check-out because of an evening flight, you have the option to extend your hotel stay till 6:00 PM for an extra fee.
