# Hekima Safaris Tour Itinerary

#### Day 1 Arrival

The group arrives at Kilimanjaro Airport (JRO). Participants are met by a representative of Hekima Safaris and transferred to a hotel which you have booked.

## Day 2 Arusha National Park

The Arusha National Park is the only park in Northern Tanzania where you may experience a walking safari. Safari in the Arusha National Park means a light trekking with a ranger. You will walk in the tropical forest and watch animals outside the car. The most amazing thing is that you will be able to walk up to the crater of Meru (the second highest peak of Tanzania and the fifth highest peak of Africa) which is located right in the park. This is a fantastic experience, worth adding to your Tanzanian adventures! After the walking safari, a jeep will drive you to the furthest part of the park – the Momela lakes where you can see pink flamingos as well as many other animals on your way. During the evening you will be transferred at Green Mountain for your dinner and overnight. Green Mountain Hotel – If you're looking for a good place, luxury and comfortable to stay, green mountain hotel will suit your needs.

## **Day 3 Tarangire National Park**

In the morning after breakfast your safari guide will arrive at the hotel and inform the receptionist that he is waiting for you. After meeting up with your driver you will travel to Tarangire National Park, and around 10:00 AM you will already be on your first safari! In this park you have the chance to see lots of wild Tanzanian animals (lions, buffaloes, giraffes, zebras, etc.), but above all else it is famous for its astonishing number of elephants, who typically tend to stay close to their drinking source, the Tarangire River. You should be aware that this is wild nature, so the guide cannot make any guarantees on the presence of specific wild animals, but you can be sure he will do his best to find everything you're looking for!

At lunch time you will be provided a meal, after which the safari will continue. In the evening you will be transferred to the hotel for your dinner and overnight. Home - Fanaka Safari, Campsite and Lodge (fanakasafaricamps.co.tz)

## **Day 4 Serengeti National Park**

After breakfast you will start the safari by being transferred to the central part of the Serengeti (also called Seronera). Here your driver will try to find the animals you're the most interested in. Closer to lunch time you will visit the Serengeti Visitor Centre, where you will be offered a lunchbox and provided with lots of interesting information not only about the animals' populations, but also about the history of the National Park. Also, in this area you will be able to see hyraxes, which are the elephant's closest relatives. It is difficult to describe in detail all the animals of the Serengeti valley, for they number in the thousands: elephants, buffalo, ostriches, giraffes, jackals, hyenas, lions, antelopes, leopards and cheetahs—just keep your eyes peeled and enjoy the nature around you. ## Day 5 Full day Serengeti National Park

After breakfast in the morning you will safari in the eastern and southern parts of the park. The greater part of these areas is a savanna with wide open spaces, which provides a likely opportunity to see cheetah hunting antelopes. Lunch boxes will be served during the game drive.

#### Day 6 Serengeti National Park

After breakfast in the morning you will be begin your game drive, It is difficult to describe in detail all the animals of the Serengeti valley, for they number in the thousands: elephants, buffalo, ostriches, giraffes, jackals, hyenas, lions, antelopes, leopards and cheetahs—just keep your eyes peeled and enjoy the nature around you. ## Day 7 Ngorongoro Crater

On this day it is best to leave the hotel as early as possible so you can see the variety of animals that are only active during the morning hours; breakfast will be packed in lunchboxes specifically for this purpose. Early in the morning you will set off for Ngorongoro Conservation Area, and after about an hour you will already be inside the crater. Ngorongoro is one of the most famous and interesting of Tanzania's national parks because here you can find the greatest number of different animal species per square kilometre. You will have the chance to see buffalo, elephants, lions, wildebeests, zebras, hippopotamus and feline species such as caracals and servals. The luckiest travellers might even see a rhinoceros, an animal whose numbers are rapidly declining. By lunch time you will arrive at the lake side, where you will be offered lunchboxes, after which the safari will continue, ending in a few hours with a transfer to your hotel. SONAYI SAFARI LODGE - Sonayi Safari Lodge is within a typical rural area of Normadic people such as Hadzabe and Datoga who Still live in traditional lifestyle. (business.site)

## Day 8 Datoga and Hadzabe Tribe

In the morning after breakfast your safari guide will be waiting for you. Today you will have a chance to visit and experience the real life of Hadza People and go with them for a real hunting not tourists one. Immerse yourself in the rich tribal history of the Hadzabe and Datoga tribes on this day adventure. Experience a "day in the life" of a local villager as you take part in cultural activities specific to each tribe. This is an extraordinary opportunity to witness authentic Tanzanian culture and sample local cuisine. In the evening you will be transferred to Arusha for your overnight. Green Mountain Hotel — If you're looking for a good place, luxury and comfortable to stay, green mountain hotel will suit your needs.

#### Day 9 Arusha Cultural Program and Night Life

The night will begin with pickup from Arusha town and this tour will take you to experience the authentic nightlife of Arusha, tailored to your preference. Options include local bars with craft beers and the best cocktails; playing pool at a local bar; singing your favorite songs in karaoke; enjoying hookah; the best nightclubs where you can dance to local music by live bands. At the end of the night, safe transport will be provided back to your preferred drop off location. ## **Day 10 Lake Duluth**

On the Lake Duluti trip we will explore Lake Duluti; an old crater that became a lake. The lake is incredibly deep. They say its more than 700m deep, but it's unconfirmed till this day. Lake Duluti is beautifully located between the green, lush forests and lends itself for a great deal of activities. From here you'll have views on Mt. Meru and sometimes even Mt. Kilimanjaro. It is a paradise for reptiles and birds. Monitor lizards can be seen sunbathing on the edge of the lake and a great variety of birds have made their homes here. Occasionally monkeys can be seen swinging from the treetops on the edge of the lake. In the evening you will head back to your place of stay for dinner and overnight. ## Day 11 Departure

Rest in the hotel and transfer to the airport.
